Within the above syllabus, the day-wise split of topics could get structured to give the best learning experience for the participants.

D. AgilePM examinations

The AgilePM foundation examination is a closed book exam to test fundamental concepts. It will run for forty minutes, will include 50 questions and the candidates need to get 50% or more marks to pass.

The Practitioner Level aims to measure whether candidates are able to apply AgilePM® methods to the running and managing of a project, blending with the best practices of Agile. They need to show that they are able to fine-tune AgilePM to different project circumstances and understand the relationship between processes, components and techniques.

The Practitioner Examination is a "Scenario based" examination lasting Two and Half hours. This is an open – book format (with access only to the AgilePM manual). Candidates need to score atleast 40 marks out of a total of 80 marks to pass this examination.

E. Who can attend

Any Project Management practitioner, seeking to familiarize themselves with a widely adopted global methodology and get certified. Unlike many other Agile courses, AgilePM is widely applicable to diverse industries and verticals.
